If you want CAT to declare the shipment on your behalf, please submit this form along with the Chain of Custody document, Waybill information, and Commercial Invoice via [Sample Stream](#).

IMPORTANT

Dear Clients,

In accordance with U.S. federal regulations, all samples must be declared 48 hours prior to the shipping date and are subject to an import fee.

While only a few sample shipments are typically held at customs, any detainment can lead to delays.

If you are shipping a large number of samples or require urgent processing, we recommend declaring your shipment.

If you are shipping samples frequently, we recommend opening an FWS eDec account and declaring your shipments yourself [at this link](#).

Please note that if you request us to declare your samples, a federal declaration fee will be invoiced to you.
